

Dave's Rave - STICKING TO THE BASICS AND GETTING THE JOB DONE! At the time of printing we are all reeling from the information overload of both a State Election, as well as a Federal, occurring one on top of the other within an 8 week period. We are hoping, now that the dust is settling, that there will be real progress in delivering functional, workable and viable Childcare that delivers the best for the kids!

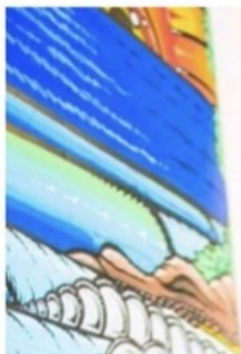

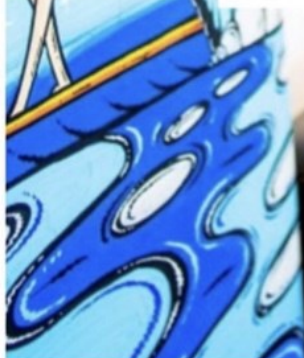

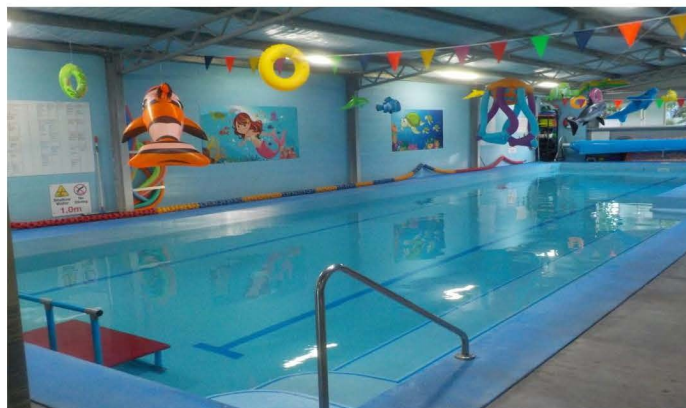
