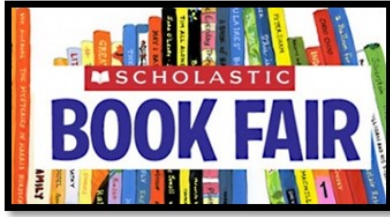

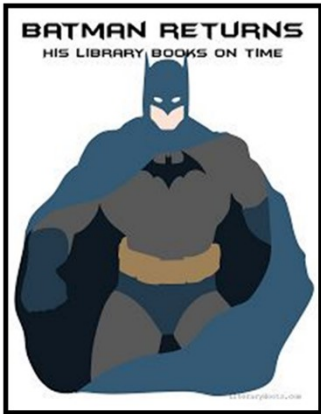
FABULOUS BOOK FAIR RESULT!

We use this platform to send out reminders about upcoming school events. It is a great tool and is available as a free download from your device's app store. Six-a-Side Soccer - Mini World Cup

Six-a-side Soccer 2019-2020

This year the Mini World Cup non-competitive six-a-side Soccer Program will be held at High St soccer fields for any interested boys and girls in Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 at Primary School. The games will be played on Thursday afternoons from 5:00pm – 6:30pm. The Season runs for approximately 16 weeks commencing from 17th October, 2019 to 13th February, 2020.

We invite players to form either school teams or social teams made up of 6 - 10 players(max). All players must be enrolled in either Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 commencing the year 2019. There will be three age Divisions – Year 1/2, Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 teams. The teams must be mixed gender with a minimum of 2 girls or 2 boys in each team. Registration is \$500 per team and must be paid before the program commences. **A Non-Competitive Team registration form needs to be completed by a parent co-ordinator (manager) and brought to a registration evening to commence the registration process (see dates below). Forms are available on the website or at Woolgoolga Real Estate.**

A 30 minute game will be played each week, catering for a maximum of 24 teams. Teams may wish to organise a plain coloured strip to represent their team (designated at registration) or they can borrow a set of bibs each week (these will be the responsibility of the coordinator). Games for Year 3/4 and 5/6 divisions will be controlled by junior referee whilst Year 1/2 division will require a parent support person on the field for each team. All players must wear shin pads.

Official Registration will be held upstairs at the The Seaview Tavern on 16th September and 23rd September 2019 from 6.30 – 7.30 pm. Please remember a parent must manage each team so registration requirements can be completed quickly and effectively and so players are correctly supervised each week. There are limited places for teams so register early to avoid disappointment.

We look forward to a fun, spirited six-a-side soccer program for younger players.
