Happy NAIDOC week to all our families. This year's theme Always Was, Always Will Be celebrates the very first footprints on this continent were those belonging to the First Nations people. It is an opportunity for us to acknowledge the important contributions of all Indigenous people and especially those in our school community. Due to camp and the High School transition for Indigenous students this week, our NAIDOC Day activities will be held next Thursday November 19. It will be an especially important day as we recognise and farewell Aunty Ange. Aunty Ange has been an integral part of our school for many, many years and we felt that recognising her outstanding service to students during our NAIDOC Day would be a fitting farewell.

Presentation Day

This is just a quick update to inform parents and students of the Year 6 to year 7 transition process that has been taking place already this year. Due to restrictions in place in relation to Covid-19, transition has been a different process in 2020 but there has still been lots going on!

Our transition processes begin with our Learning Support Team meetings. This is where a team of teachers from Woolgoolga High School visit our feeder primary schools and meet with the current year 6 teachers, learning and support staff and principals. These meetings give us an insight into the wonderful students that will be attending our school the next year and assists with class placements. Students who may require additional transition visits are also identified within these meetings.

The next step in the transition timeline is our Roadshow visits. These visits have been slightly different this year but involve myself (Year 7 2021 Year Adviser), Mr Ian Cook (Head Teacher Wellbeing) and Mr Daniel Sweed (Student Support Officer) attending each of the primary schools, showcasing the activities and excursions that take place at our school and answering questions from the year 6 students themselves.

In week 5, we will hold an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Orientation Day. On this day, ATSI students from each of the primary schools come together to showcase the Aboriginal Programs and supports that we have in place at Woolgoolga High School. On this day, WHS staff such as Mrs Jo Hine, Ms Kelly Hine, Ms Blake Cusack, and myself will provide a tour of the school, participate in cultural activities such as a smoking ceremony and the students will participate in a Gumbaynggirr language lesson.

An Orientation Day for all students will then take place on Tuesday, 1 December 2020. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, parents will not be able to attend on this day (other than to purchase school uniforms), but instead we will hold a parent information session via zoom at 6.00pm. Orientation Day will be an incredibly exciting day for all year 6 students. They will finally get a taste of high school, catching the bus to and from school, an assembly in our hall, a music concert and some mini-lessons run by high school teachers.

We understand that it is a very busy time for most families, and would like to reiterate that staff at our school are here to assist in any way. If you have any questions relation to Year 6 to Year 7 Transition, and would like to speak to me, please call Woolgoolga High School on 02 6654 1500.
