Attendance

Regular attendance at school for every student is essential if students are to achieve their potential, and increase their

career and life options. Schools in partnerships with parents are responsible for promoting the regular attendance of students. While parents are legally responsible for the regular attendance of their children, school staff, as part of their duty of care, record and monitor part and whole day absences.

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record.

Scripture notes

Scripture will commence on February 18. If you do not want your child to attend scripture classes please ask the office for an exemption form. These are due back in by February 18.

Arrival times

There is no supervision for students until 8.15am each day. Please ensure that your child does not arrive at school before this time.

Improving the Learning and Support Journey pilot: Information for Parents/Carers

Our school is currently part of a Department of Education pilot testing new approaches to improve the learning and support journey for students with disability and their families. The pilot is testing new approaches to the Access Request process that is used to apply for additional educational supports for a student with disability and additional learning and support needs.

Term 1 2020, students at all schools in the Grafton area who apply for additional educational supports such as support class placement will go through the new pilot process, which is being tested under the Department of Education's [Disability Strategy](#). It is hoped that this process will be more streamlined, transparent and consistent, and will improve things for parents/carers and children by:

- creating new resources for parents/carers to help you understand the process and make more informed decisions for your child
- reducing administration for schools and parents
- ensuring students are considered by local panels who know them and local contextual information of the schools
- creating a student profile and action plan that is strengths based and utilised across the Grafton schools
- allocating a care coordinator in the school to act as one point of contact for you as parents/carers.

The first step for any parent with concerns about their child's learning is still to discuss these with their child's classroom teacher.

Parents are invited to learn more about the pilot and the new approach to accessing additional educational supports by asking the school for a copy of the

Educational supports for children and young people with disability and learning and support needs – a guide for parents

This pilot aims to develop an improved process that meets the needs of all students across the state. There have already been improvements in 2019 for students with disability including automatically rolling over integration funding support for students who currently receive Integration Funding Support and are transitioning from primary to high school, and placement of students in support classes for Year 7 being considered in Year 5 to ensure parents/carers are informed earlier where their child will be attending high school.

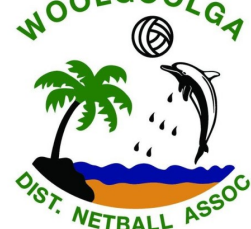
