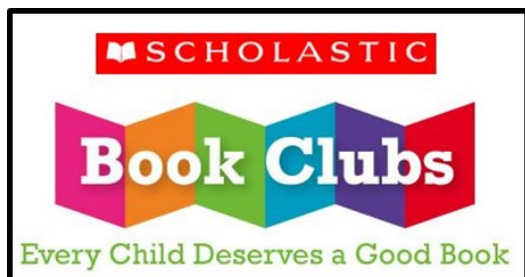

Every order gives us bonus points to spend on resources from Scholastic!

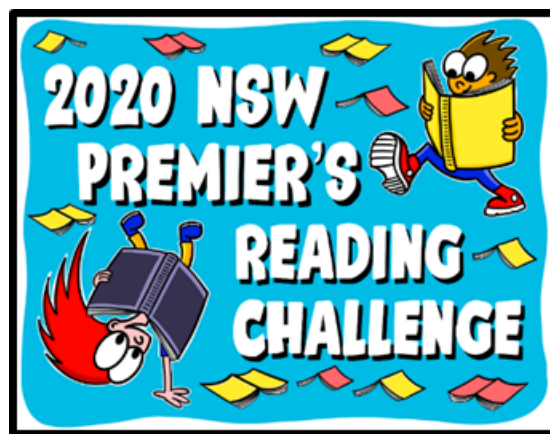
2020 PREMIERS READING CHALLENGE

Absence notes go to the class teacher, if you use email or the Skoolbag app to explain absences we deal with those and the teacher is advised. Later this term we will be using a text message system, there will be notification in the newsletter when this happens.

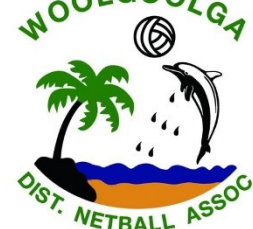
