Worm Warriors

Earlier this year our P and C were successful in applying for a MAD Green grant from Coffs Harbour City Council. Many thanks to Katie Pledger who wrote and submitted the grant for the school.

The grant is for us to engage our students in developing their knowledge and skills in managing and reducing our waste through establishing and maintaining worm farms. Eight Stage 3 student volunteers have formed the Worm Warriors. They have surveyed all classes on their knowledge of worm farms and their use of food scraps each day.

We were successful in obtaining 8 new compostable scrap bins from

Grafton City Council for use in each class. Each Worm Warrior has been assigned a class to look after. We will purchase 4 worm farms (one for each stage) and these will be in action over the next few weeks.

Stage 3 Language

Mr Skinner commenced Gumbaynggirr language with both Stage 3 classes today. We are very fortunate to have Mr Skinner on our staff as he had completed Certificate 3 in Gumbaynggirr Language through Muurrbay Aboriginal Language and Culture Co-Operative. He has developed some great interactive resources for the students. These classes will be held each Tuesday.
