Data Collection

All schools in Australia are required to take part in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on school students requiring extra support and or adjustments to enable them to participate in education on the same basis as other students. This is aimed at providing all Australian schools, education authorities and the community with a clear picture of the number of students needing extra support.

The 2020 data collection will involve the collection of the following information at the school level:

- The number of students receiving adjustments to enable them to participate in education on the same basis as other students
- The level of adjustments provided (no adjustment at this time, supplementary, substantial or extensive adjustment)
- Where known the student's type of difficulty

Once this data has been collated, it will be de-identified and aggregated at the system level (i.e. Primary, Secondary, Special and Combined school setting) before providing it to the Commonwealth Department of Education. This ensures that no student's identity can be ascertained.

The Australian Government of Education will use the information collected for the purposes of preparing reports for briefing Education Ministers. The aggregated data may also be used to inform national policy development.
